Prize giving ceremonies

- Prize giving ceremonies approx. 10min after last rider of the competition
- 6 best riders will be invited to the prize giving from each competition
- Riders can convene for the prize giving at the Indoor Arena
- The groom and the owner of the winning horse, should be also present at the ceremony

Prize money & prizes in kind

- For the payment of the prize money placing riders should leave their account information to the show office!
- Bank account number, SWIFT - / BIC-code, home address, bank name
- Prizes in kind are available from the show office during the show

Stables, accreditation and parking

Stables

- List of horses stabling will be available at the show ground
- Stable is open daily 05:00 – 23:00, accredited persons only.
- Hay can be bought from the stable manager between 9 a.m. to 8 p.m. Payment only in cash for the stable manager. (1euro/kilo or 12euros/bale).
- Horses are staying at the temporary boxes. Shavings: peat

- Please clean the boxes before you leave.
- Horses shall be marked with their ID-numbers (identification number) when they are outside of the stables.
- There will be no entry to the main stable!
- If your own treating veterinarian is coming to the show, please inform him/her that an informal vet meeting will take place after the vet check in the warm –up arena. The vets arriving later can notify their presence in the competition to delegates by phone.
- **Please check your horses temperature immediately after arrival; stable personnel will record the temperature. Please continue to check the temperature daily. Recording the horses' temperature is mandatory in all FEI events, and it is done for the benefit of the horses.**

Accreditation

Entry to the stable is given according to the FEI rules.

- Rider (1), groom (1) and horse owner(s; as in FEI passport) will get bracelets. Riders will be photographed and will get access cards from the show office.
- Accreditation starts at the show office on Tuesday 12:00. The riders sign the accreditations for the persons accompany them.
- Please remember to show receipt at the show office for the entry fee.
- Coaches can also sign their wristbands at the show office.
- In connection with accreditation show your horses vaccinations at the show office
- Entry to the show is free of charge
- Riders and grooms can have small breakfast and lunch (Thu - Sun from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m.) from a separate lounge at the restaurant area.
- All international riders, grooms and horse owners can participate Kyra Kyrklund's clinic on Sunday 2nd of June. The stand for riders, grooms and owners is nearby the stable area.

Parking

- Parking of the lorries and trailers is located 50-100m from the stables. Stable personnel will guide you to find the right parking place.
- If you have reserved electricity for your truck, you will get more information at the show office. Electricity must be paid in advance to Ympäristöpalvelut Tuominen Oy account:

- Trailers/small horse trucks will be parked by the organizer nearby the competition area.
- Shuttle Service is available from the parking lot (at the city center) to the venue as follows:

- Outside these times, you can park your car for short term parking (i.e. max. 1 hour) to the competition area. Audience and all others must park their cars to the dedicated parking area at the town center.
- On Tuesday and Wednesday all riders can park their car to the venue arena.

Horse Inspections and warm-up (HI)

- Take your horses passport with you to the HI.
- Horses passports will be checked and collected at the HI and retained at the show office during the show. Passports are given back to the riders from the show office after their last competition.
- Order of all HI will be as follows;
 - Categories
 - Participating countries; 1. Estonia, 2. Finland, 3. Russia, 4. Sweden
- Horse inspections are held at the indoor arena. See timetable attached
- More detailed schedule for HI:s will be published on this side and the notice board of the stable.
- Horse inspection will be done immediately when the horse has arrived to the venue. Rider/groom must measure the heat and show horse passport and vaccinations before one can take the horse to the stable area.
- Heat control will be held through the competition - all horses must be checked every morning and every evening. Stewards will control this.

Riding & lunging on the area

Warm-up arena, Indoor Arena

- Riding at the competition arena is divided to groups.
- Lunging by booking only! Lunging times between 5 a.m. to 6.15 a.m.
- For the safety reasons;
 - dogs must be on a leash at all times, please do not take dogs to the riding halls arena.
 - leave your horses blankets on the marked place next to the door.
- There are stewards at all the time on the warm-up arena, do not hesitate to ask them if there is something you are wondering about.
